TOWN MOOR, town of Narberth County of Pembrokeshire

Mr Salmon has applied to the Welsh Ministers for consent under section 38 of the Commons Act 2006 to carry out restricted works on Town Moor, Narberth.

The proposed works are: replacement of section of failed drainage including the erection of temporary 'heras' type fencing and the reinstatement of two paths where drainage crosses paths. The drainage works will cover a site area of approx. 970 square metres and there will be a total of 300 metres (length) of temporary fencing laid in sections. The works/fencing will be located immediately to the north-west of the car park below the school.
